In your response, be sure to keep a few things in mind:

1. BE SPECIFIC

Describe your academic goals especially as they relate to graduate school. Are there particular programs or schools you want to attend? Are you considering any unique academic or professional pathways?

Articulate how your future graduate studies and degree will help you to land your dream career.

2. DO YOUR RESEARCH

To answer the second part of the question, you need to do your research!

Describe what stands out to you and what resource you're most looking forward to using.

3. DESCRIBE YOUR LEADERSHIP STYLE & GOALS

The Fellowship is designed to cultivate academic and professional leadership. Be sure to describe who you are as a leader and how you're hoping to grow.

OTHER TIPS:

- **Read the Question Carefully:** Ensure you understand what the question is asking before you start writing your response.
- **Be Concise:** Focus on providing the necessary information without going over the 250-300 word limit.
- **Stay Relevant:** Be direct in addressing the prompt.
- **Provide Specific Examples:** The strongest responses will be those that discuss tangible goals.
- **Use Clear Language:** Write in clear and straightforward language to ensure your response is easy to understand.
- **Answer in Complete Sentences:** Even though short answer questions are brief, they still require complete sentences.
- **Proofread Your Response:** Take a moment to review your answer for any errors in grammar, spelling, or punctuation before submitting it.
- **Check for Understanding:** After completing your response, ensure that you have addressed all aspects of the question.
- **Be Confident:** Present your response with confidence. You are an expert of your own experiences.
