STRATEGIC PILLAR #1: FOCUS ON OUR CORE TO SERVE MORE

OVERVIEW

At the heart of Leadership Brainery's work is the Ambassador Fellowship (LBAF). This high-touch, eight-month experience equips talented undergraduate leaders with the knowledge, confidence, and networks to enroll in graduate school and thrive in advanced careers. By focusing on program quality and relevance, we ensure that each participant gains the tools and support to achieve not only postgraduate success but also long-term generational prosperity.

Goal: Strengthen and scale the LB Ambassador Fellowship to serve 50 students annually by Year 3 (2028) while maintaining excellence, relevance, and measurable impact.

Influence Practices: Provide colleges, universities, and employers with practical tools, training, and data to strengthen recruitment, admissions, and advancement practices.
